

Tournament Rules

- All participants must be USTA members
- USTA Point Penalty System is in effect.
- 12 point tie break in all 3 sets.
- Play in playoff for third and fourth place and consolation is mandatory.
- No telephone entries will be accepted.
- All entries must be accompanied by completed entry form, check, and photocopy of USTA card. For additional entry forms, contact tournament chairpersons or host clubs.
- Each player is responsible for finding out the time of his or her next round. Tournament start times will be posted online at Tennislink via the USTA website two days before the tournament begins.

USTA/MS Age Eligibility Chart

A player is eligible to play in an age division until the month of his/her birthday. For example, a player who turns 15 on July 1, may play 14 and under if the tournament starts on or before June 30. If the tournament starts on July 1, he/she must play 16 and under.

Abbreviations:

DD-Delaware District

UR-UR is the abbreviation for Unranked tournaments. UR events are designed for entry-level USTA junior members who have never received a sectional ranking. Those ranked in other district and those ranked in top 50% of Delaware District are ineligible in any age group for the Delaware unranked tournaments. After winning any ranked or unranked tournament in 2011, a player may not play in any other unranked tournaments in 2011.

DR is the abbreviation for District Ranking. They are designed for the developing for the developing player who is either pursuing a district ranking, working his/her way up to the SR level, or who elects to play tournaments close to home. DR results will count toward USTA/MS year-end sectional ranking, but will not fulfill sectional ranking requirements or affect endorsement. DRs are open to all USTA junior members, except where designated as "closed."

Consult your district office for specific ranking. SR is the abbreviation for Sectional Ranking series tournaments. SRs count toward USTA/MS sectional ranking and are designed for the serious ranking and

are designed for the serious competitor. SRs are open to all USTA junior members based on current USTA/MS standings. SRE is the abbreviation for Sectional Ranking Endorsement tournaments. SREs count toward sectional ranking and provide competition among the outstanding USTA/MS juniors who are pursuing USTA national tournament eligibility. SREs are open to USTA/MS residents based on current sectional standings.

DD Ranking Requirements

Any Junior who resides, goes to school, or has
parents working in DE is eligible for a DE Jr.
ranking if they meet the following criteria. Jr
players must play in the DE State Jr. Tournament
or the Oscar Sebastian Jr. tournament. A player
must have at least one win in a tournament to
qualify for ranking. **Non Delaware residents
must notify ranking chair of eligibility status by
October 31, 2011.** The new points-per-round
ranking system encourages juniors to play a
minimum of 3 tournaments to receive a
maximum number of points The results from a
player's best 3 tournaments will count for
ranking purposes. Winners will receive an
additional 30 points and a finalist will receive 20.
Players in unranked tournaments will receive
half the points awarded in ranked tournaments.

Procedure for entries: Register online at
www.ms.usta.com or mail the enclosed form with
checks to host club or director. Start times for at
least the first match will be posted on Tennislink
via the USTA website 48 hours before the start
of the tournament.
